Notice To The Public On Submittal Of Grant Proposal
To Environmental Protection Agency

The Redevelopment Authority (RDA) of the City of Oshkosh is submitting a grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for up to \$400,000 in assessment and cleanup funds through the Brownfields Multi-Purpose Pilot Grant. The purpose of this pilot is to award one grant per EPA region for both assessment and cleanup work at a specific brownfields site. The RDA/City is applying for this pilot grant to assist with future redevelopment activities at 362 Michigan Street. If successfully awarded, a 20% match from the RDA/City will be required.

On Wednesday, January 25, 2012 the RDA will be asked to authorize submittal of the grant application. Interested persons will be able to comment on the proposed grant at the RDA's 4:00 pm meeting at the Oshkosh City Hall.
