LICENSE IS VALID FOR ONE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31. Licenses purchased after January 1 in any given calendar year will also expire December 31 of that year; and license fees will not be pro-rated. License required for chickens permitted in one & two family homes (R-1 or R-2) only. A license is not required for chickens permitted in A-1 and A-2 districts.
