...ABOUT FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY.

We here at the Oshkosh Fire Department believe that the best time to fight fires and accidental injury is before they occur. In order to accomplish this, we have devised a series of fire and life safety presentations. These presentations are available, free of charge, to schools, pre-schools, daycare centers, businesses, nursing or group home staff and residents, community organizations, and any other interested parties in the Oshkosh area.

SOME OF THE AVAILABLE TOPICS INCLUDE:

GENERAL FIRE SAFETY

In this program a variety of subjects are covered, including: Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, What to do in case of a fire, and Common household hazards and how to lessen their danger.

PRE-SCHOOL FIRE SAFETY

This presentation has been developed to teach this high-risk age group basic fire safety. Included in the program: Never play with matches and lighters, Crawling low under smoke, Getting out and staying out, Calling 9-1-1, Stop, Drop, and Roll, and The firefighter is a friend.



SENIOR FIRE SAFETY

Since people age 65 and older account for half of the state's fire injuries and deaths, a special presentation targets this age group. Topics range from basic fire safety to candles to cooking to fall prevention.

EXTINGUISHER TRAINING

This presentation allows its participants to learn the various types of fire extinguishers and how to use them. Each participant will show what they have learned by putting out a small, controlled fire on their own.

EVACUATION TRAINING

Essential for any business. This presentation focuses on the safest practices to implement during any emergency situation (fire, chemical spill, etc.).



FIRST AID

Basic first aid practices are taught, including: What to do and not to do when arriving at an accident scene, how to stop bleeding, treatment of burns, etc.

SEASONAL SAFETY

Christmas and other winter holidays, Summer (swimming, biking, boating), Fourth of July, Halloween Safety, etc. are all available throughout their respective times of the year.
